Elevated details like honey-toned wood furniture, botanical wallcoverings, and a sake display wall add depth and intimacy, while playful nods to Tokyo's urban art scene, like a wheat paste-inspired bar front, inject a sense of cultural energy. With over 200 seats, including a spacious 1,400-square-foot patio, Sunda Detroit offers a dynamic dining experience where design, storytelling, and hospitality collide.
